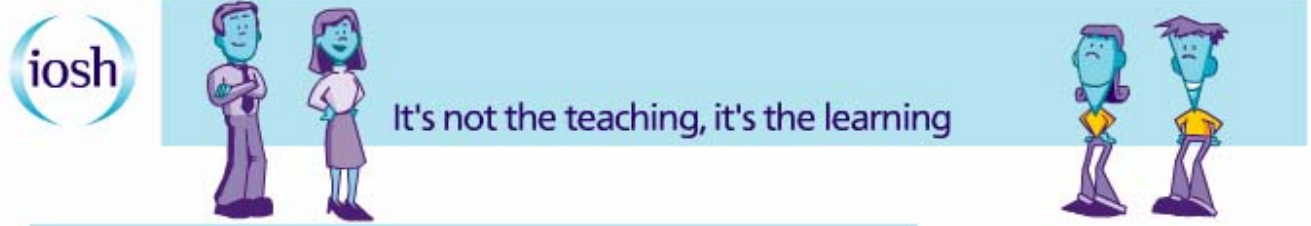

Update on new course



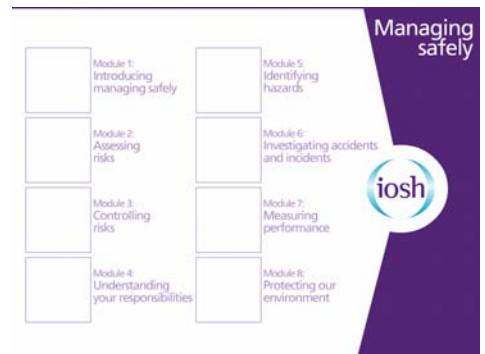
